

FINANCIAL SNAPSHOT

The Education Foundation Osceola County is overseen by a committed Board of Directors that ensures responsible management of all funds. Our dedicated team adheres to best practices in financial stewardship and administration. Together, we manage an annual budget of over \$2 million, directly supporting 85 schools, more than 78,000 students, and 8,000 district staff members—all made possible through the support of our community and generous donors.

OTHER INITIATIVES

COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS

provided financial literacy support and scholarship application guidance to seniors through the "Got College? Got Careers?" initiative. Osceola County, previously known for having one of the lowest collegegoing rates in Florida, has now exceeded the state average. For the 2024–2025 school year, the county's students have achieved a third-place ranking in college attendance statewide.
