Free Store Shopping Guidelines

You may shop **once per month** on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday **from 3 to 6 p.m.** **Check in closes promptly at 5:30 pm.**

The shopper **agrees not to bring children or other guests** to the store. Store space is very limited and the Fire Marshall prohibits overcrowding.

Shopper agrees to check in at the front desk and **show a photo ID each time they shop** - school employee photo identification or driver's license accepted.

Shopper will **bring reusable canvas** totes to carry purchases to their cars. This saves the environment from so many plastic bags being used.

Shopper agrees that all items are **for students and classroom use only** and may be taken only by teachers of public schools in Osceola County. Items of significant value, such as audio-visual equipment, furniture, etc., become school property.

A Gift For Teaching is not responsible for merchandise after it leaves the premises. There are no returns or exchanges allowed. Shoppers are welcome to contribute supplies, time and money!!
